



## MADFIDDLE AUDITIONS

The MadFiddle audition is a Zoom meeting with student and parent(s). The purpose is to evaluate the student's playing level and needs while understanding their goals and addressing questions about the program.

Auditionees perform a piece in any genre (3 min max) and a scale of choice, followed by ear assessment that does not require advance preparation. The length of the audition is 20-30 minutes. Parents may choose to connect over the phone prior to the audition so the student may take the audition independently. The fee is \$20.

Audition results reserve a spot for the '23-'24 season, beginning early September.
